GENERAL

- The Kilcoy Courthouse Art Gallery is open Thursday to Monday and most Public Holidays from 9am – 1pm.
- Our monthly general meeting is held at the gallery, normally 2nd Thursday of the month at 2pm. Details will be sent out via e-mail. All members encouraged to come along.
- As KASI is a Not-For-Profit organisation we rely totally on volunteers' help with manning the gallery (**our priority**), fundraising, exhibitions, raffle sales and market days. Many hands make light work - all volunteer helpers are greatly appreciated and, if exhibiting artwork, enjoy a lower annual membership fee and sales commission.
- KASI holds occasional "art activities" at various locations around the area. These are informal, fun and often free. They are a great opportunity to meet fellow artists, gain inspiration and make new friends. The time and venue is decided at the monthly meeting.
- Tea and coffee are available at the gallery for a \$2.00 donation.

VALUES

KASI is proud of the Kilcoy Courthouse Art Gallery, the high standard and diverse range of artwork on display by our dynamic and creative artists and our hardworking volunteers that ensure KASI and the Gallery continues to thrive.

MEMBERSHIP

KASI welcomes all practicing artists (recreational, amateur or professional) and those interested in the arts to become members. Individuals may self-nominate their preferred membership type at the time of application (see a summary below).

KASI's financial year is from 1 January to 31 December. Our Annual General Meeting (AGM) is usually held toward the end of February and you must be a financial member in order to vote to elect or nominate for a position.

New exhibiting artist applicants will be asked to show three (3) samples or images of their artwork to the KASI Exhibition Team, as part of the membership application process.
