Sunshine Coast Plein Air Paint Out 12-19 August 2018

Sunshine Coast Plein Air Painters (SCPAP) is a group of artists who enjoy painting *en plein air* (in the open) with similar minded artists. Getting outside, seeing and painting from life to capture all the colours and tones that interpret the environment as only an artist can. The group uses Facebook to communicate. Individual members post a suggested painting location and date and invite other members to join them if they are interested. Any medium, any level.

SCPAP also arranges a weeklong paint out each year in August in conjunction with the Yandina Street Fair. This year, local and interstate plein air artists are invited to join them for a week painting at selected locations and help Yandina celebrate 150 years of settlement.

Painting Locations

Various locations on the Sunshine Coast including beach, town and country scenes. Morning and afternoon locations each day.

Accommodation Options

There are a number of accommodation styles available in the area for those travelling to the paint out. Camping, B&B, hotel or holiday apartment. SCPAP is not able to book accommodation for you, however please indicate at registration what type of accommodation you require and we will respond with some local options.

Exhibition

All paintings produced during the paint out can be exhibited for sale in conjunction with the Yandina Street Fair. Paintings can be exhibited 'off the easel' – unmatted, unframed, matted or framed depending on your style of work. The exhibition will be held at Connections, Cnr Low and Farrell Sts, Yandina on 18-19 Aug with an official opening on the evening of 17 Aug.

For those who may be interested in a little more excitement, we are planning a trip to Double Island Point for a two night camp and paint, starting Friday morning the 10th and returning Sunday afternoon the 12th prior to the main event. You will need a four wheel drive and camping equipment as this involves a drive up Teewah Beach on the low tides so no need to get your car wet, but there will be some soft sand at times. We will have at least one qualified and experienced four wheel driver on the trip in case someone gets bogged. Camping will be at the Freshwater camping ground at Double Island Point. Please notify us early if you wish to be part of this.
