- Maximum 3 artworks can be entered per artist.
- Entry fees (non-refundable): \$15 per artwork for SASI members and Youth, \$25 per artwork for non-members. Completed and signed entry form and payment must be received by SASI no later than 5pm on 24 June 2019. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Artists entering the Youth Art Prize must be aged between 15-20 years inclusive and must indicate date of birth on entry form.
- Entries must be the unaided work of the artist, completed after June 2017 and not have previously won a prize in an art awards/art prize. Prizes won in Local Shows are the exception as they are not considered professional competitions with high prize money and professional judges.
- Size of all 2D artworks, including frame, must not exceed 110cm on the longest side. 3D artworks must be within 110cm squared and movable by 2 people.
- No artworks will be accepted that require power to operate (video, lighting, movement, screens, sound).
- Artworks must be well presented, clean and prepared for hanging with D-rings placed no lower than 1/3 down from the top on each side of the artwork with picture wire or cord attached.
- Each artwork must have a label attached securely to the back of the artwork with the artist's name, phone number, title of work, category, medium and sale
- Artwork details cannot be changed after entry form is received.
- All entries must be for sale except for Youth entries, which is optional. SASI will retain 20% of all sales. Artists will be paid within 30 days of the exhibition
