Policy on Al-Generated Artwork

1. Background

This policy outlines guidelines for including Artist Members' Al-generated artwork in the Kilcoy Courthouse Art Gallery exhibitions. The approach encourages innovation while maintaining the gallery's focus on human-created art.

2. Introduction

An Al artwork is a piece of digital art created using artificial intelligence technology.

Many artists now use AI as a tool to enhance their creative process. Some work directly with algorithms to generate art, while others use AI for ideation, composition, or iterative development.

As AI becomes more integrated into the creative process, the gallery recognizes its potential while maintaining a strong focus on human artistic expression. This policy ensures AI-generated works are included in a controlled and transparent manner at the Kilcoy Courthouse Art Gallery, balancing innovation with tradition.

3. Application of the Policy

Submission Limit: Each Artist Member may submit up to five works per general exhibition changeover, but only one work may be Al-generated.

General Exhibition Labelling Requirement: All Al-generated works must be clearly labelled as Al-Generated to ensure transparency for curators and audiences.

Mini-Masters Room: All work may be displayed in the Mini-Masters room with the work clearly labeled.

Artist of the Month: The use and number of works generated by AI in the Artist of the Month display is left to the discretion of the Artist Member. If AI is used the work must be clearly labelled as AI-generated.

Transparency: Artists may provide a brief description of how AI was used on the back of their work for purchaser's information.

Exhibition Considerations: The Kilcoy Art Society Inc Executive will monitor Al submissions to maintain a well-balanced exhibition that reflects both traditional and emerging artistic practices.
